The mission of Hopewell United Methodist Church is to "help Christians grow and help grow Christians." Therefore, Youth Ministries seeks to provide opportunities for youth to grow in their relationships with God as well as to serve others so they will glorify God and feel God's loving presence. In part, students are better able to accomplish that by participating in summer mission activities. The Summer Youth Intern assists the Director of Youth Ministries, youth leaders, and the youth on that journey.

Requirements:

- The Youth Intern should not only see him/herself as a spiritual mentor for teenagers, but as a living example for what a Christian life should be.
- The Youth Intern must have completed his/her Freshman year in college.
- The Youth Intern should have access to some form of personal transportation.
- The Youth Intern will be subject to a background check.

Objective:

 The objective for the Youth Intern will be to grow in service and leadership in his/her walk with God.

Organization:

- The Youth Intern will work under the direct supervision of both the Director and Assistant Director of Youth Ministries.
- The Youth Intern will function as, and be treated as, a part-time staff member of Hopewell United Methodist Church—and, therefore, represents Hopewell United Methodist Church.

Responsibilities:

- Provide administrative assistance in the planning and execution of summer mission trips and retreats.
- Supervise students and assist in group leadership.
- Attend meetings/planning sessions with youth ministry leaders as necessary.
- Maintain a regular work schedule.
- Attend summer mission trips and retreats.

Compensation:

- This is a temporary, 10 week position with a total compensation of 400 hrs.
- The Youth Ministry Intern will be paid \$4,000 for the 10 weeks.

Please note that the intern MUST adhere to and support Hopewell's Safe Sanctuary policy. He/she will be expected to attend the Safe Sanctuary training upon hire.
