READ

Luke 2:1-20

REFLECT

What struck you as you read this story in Luke? Did God show you anything new?

When did someone offer you care and hospitality, or intentionally invite and welcome you? How did you feel?

Consider Pastor Amy's description of the innkeeper and Ed Robb's statement that this person's hospitality, "was the first gift presented to Mary and Joseph on that bustling starry night in Bethlehem, before the wise men arrived with frankincense, gold and myrrh. Perhaps it was the gift of the innkeeper who cared. Someone with a listening ear who heard their need; someone who, though the inn was filled, made room."

How does this description encourage or challenge you?

Do you know your neighbors? How might you begin to connect or re-engage with them in this season?

God of love, thank you for noticing, welcoming, and loving me. Show me who You want me to notice this week and help me to offer hospitality and be a good neighbor. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DO
