



Health & Safety Policy

The health and safety of our children and families is of the utmost importance to Hopewell Christian Preschool. We will continue to update these protocols as necessary.

Facial Coverings

HCP is currently mask optional. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask should do so and all choices will be honored and respected. Should our community level change our masking policy may change as well.

Health Affidavit & Waiver

Parents are required to sign an affidavit and a waiver at the beginning of the school year. The affidavit is a promise not to send the student to school sick. Any existing chronic conditions (ex. Allergies) need to have a doctor's note on file.

Snack

Snack is provided by the preschool and distributed by the teachers. If a student has an allergy that requires an epi-pen a snack must be provided for that student.

Sanitation

Handwashing and disinfecting throughout the school day will continue to be a priority.

Exposure to COVID-19

If the Preschool Director is notified that a child tested positive for Covid, the director will email the parents in the class to let them know about the exposure.

Positive for COVID-19

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 they should not attend school and should quarantine at home for 5 days. If the symptoms persist past 5 days your child should continue to quarantine until the symptoms are resolved. Upon return to school, it is recommended that your child should wear a mask for 5 days.

HCP reserves the right to handle the positive case, any contact tracing and quarantine measures as they see fit based on the circumstances of the case, the community transmission level and the latest Covid guidance.
